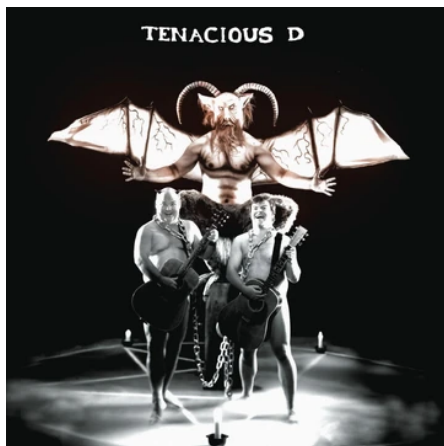
They started playing on the sidelines,

2001! The year they signed with Epic Records, and just after one year, they
released their first album, named “Tenacious D”, which featured a full band, and a
certain Dave Grohl on drums, who they befriended a little while back.



After their first album, they released a single, and a live show DVD, and shortly
after, in 2006, they starred in their very own Motion Picture.

TENACIOUS D In The Pick of Destiny (MOVIE OVERVIEW)

The Movie is about how Kyle Gass and Jack Black met “not realistically of course”, but more of just a comedy that's filled with humor that only a few people can enjoy, like me, sure it's very weird and sometimes just plain corny and crude, but it's just a fun movie, it feels like a movie plot you'd make with your best friend.

In the movie, we see Jables/JB (Jack Black) run away as a kid to Hollywood, where he finds Kyle Gass playing by the beach, initially Jables thinks KG is this God of rock? JB and KG eventually form the band after JB gets a Kickass guitar from KG. 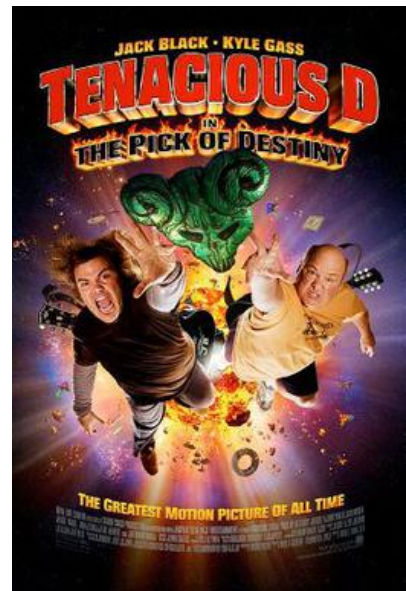
In the end, they use the horn as “The Bong of Destiny”, and they live in their crappy apartment, rent free.

ALBUM AND DVD COVERS
